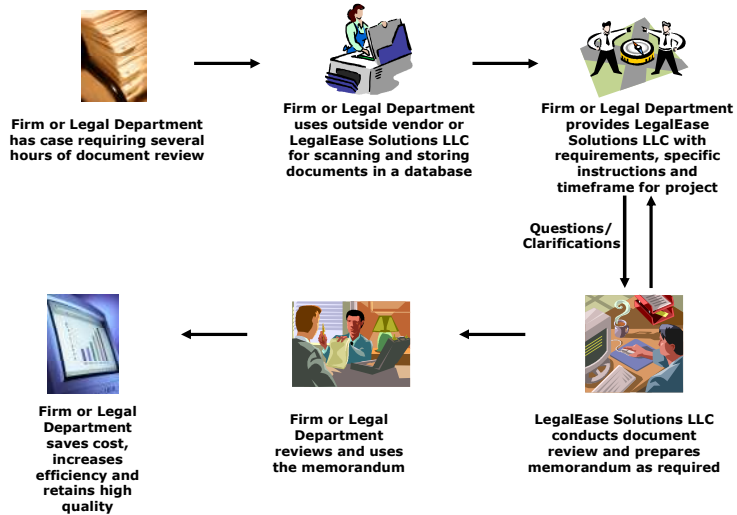
Introduction:

Profile of Recent Document Review Projects

Credit Agreement Review

A mid-sized Detroit area law firm retained our services in preparation for litigation arising out of a credit relationship gone bad between the firm's client (a national bank) and the lender (auto-parts supplier). The credit agreement between the parties spanned over 12 years and included a voluminous original credit agreement, several significant amendments, and all ancillary agreements including security agreements, mortgages, promissory notes, and letters of credit.

The documents pertaining to the above had been scanned by the law firm and transmitted to LegalEase electronically. LegalEase was asked to review the credit agreement, amendments, and ancillary agreements and summarize the agreements, track changes between the original credit agreement and amendments, and prepare a memorandum.

LegalEase staffed the project with four of its Indian attorneys and gave the law firm a turn-around time of 36 hours, saving the law firm (and its client) time and expense.

Mortgage Review

A national lending institution retained LegalEase to review a number of real estate mortgages tied to a credit facility that the institution had extended to a borrower, who was delinquent on payments pursuant to the credit facility. The lending institution required a study of the collateral involved in the transaction should it default the borrower on its delinquent payments.

The mortgage documents were not in electronic format. LegalEase arranged for the documents to be picked up from the lending institution, and had them scanned and returned the originals.

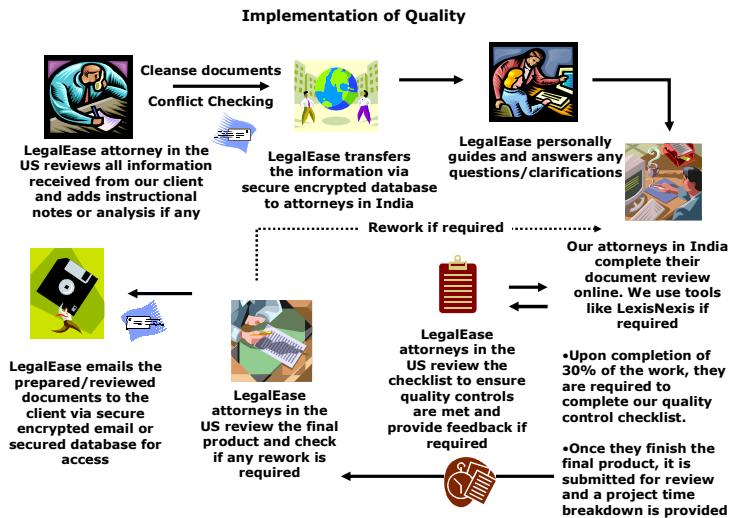
LegalEase was asked to review nearly 50 mortgages on real property nation-wide and prepare a memorandum assessing the lending institution's collateralization.

Training

Training is a continuously evolving process and will be imparted to all personnel regularly. Initial and continuous training methodology is detailed below.
